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- ❖ The Core Group meeting of Infrastructure and Overlays Committee held on 29<sup>th</sup> September 2014 decided to initiate tenders for setting up overlays at the following venues:
  - i. Squash Court, Chandrasekharan Nair Stadium, Thiruvananthapuram
  - ii. Jimmy George Indoor Stadium, Vellayambalam, Thiruvananthapuram
  - iii. Shooting Range, Vattiyoorkavu, Thiruvananthapuram
  - iv. University Stadium, Palayam, Thiruvananthapuram
- ❖ The Core Group meeting of the Ceremonies Committee held on 29<sup>th</sup> September 2014 recommended the finalization of design of the torch and the modalities of lighting the lamp in consultation with Shri. T K Rajeevkumar, Creative Director of Ceremonies
- ❖ The Purchase Committee meeting held on 29<sup>th</sup> September 2014 under the chairmanship of Shri. M Sivasankar IAS recommended to purchase:
  - i. Weightlifting equipment from M/s Uesaka, Japan, represented by M/s Bajaj & Co., India at a price of \$1,23,588
  - ii. Badminton equipment from M/s Victor, Japan represented by Bikazoom, India for a price of \$ 43,187 and local charges of Rs. 6,14,141/-
- ❖ The Executive Committee meeting held on 30<sup>th</sup> September 2014 under the chairmanship of Shri. Thiruvanchoor Radhakrishnan, Hon'ble Minister for Sports decided to:
  - i. Consider proposals for additional competition events and to revise the number of competition events in Aquatics, Archery, Boxing, Canoeing & Kayaking, Cycling and Rowing as per guidelines issued by Convener, Games Technical Conduct Committee, based on the proposals from concerned National Sports Federations
  - ii. Accepted the landscaping proposal from Jawaharlal Nehru Tropical Botanical Garden and Research Institute for Games Village, Menamkulam for an amount of Rs.49,97,861/-
  - iii. Alter the number of carbon-fibre boats undergoing tender process from 12 to 8, in all 6 categories and to float a global tender immediately for the purchase of 4 high-quality pure-carbon boats for all 6 categories considering recommendations from respective sports federations and to provide Indian athletes exposure to the best of international standard equipment
- ❖ The following domestic bids for supply of equipment were opened on 30<sup>th</sup> September & 1<sup>st</sup> October 2014
  - i. Boxing – 2 Nos
  - ii. Athletics – 3nos
  - iii. Kabaddi – 2 Nos
  - iv. Kho-Kho – 1 No
  - v. Rowing – 1 No
- ❖ The Core Group meeting of the Games Village Committee under the chairmanship of Shri. V Sasi, MLA held on 1<sup>st</sup> October 2014 recommended that
  - i. KWA shall arrange water supply to the Games Village at a cost of Rs. 65 lakhs
  - ii. KSEB shall set up power infrastructure inside Games Village at a cost of Rs. 39, 46,520/- and energy charges estimated at Rs. 96, 60,000/-
