- ❖ The Purchase Committee meeting held on 7<sup>th</sup> October 2014 under the chairmanship of Shri. M Sivasankar IAS recommended:
  - Purchase of Boxing equipment from M/s. TopTen, UK represented by M/s Swatantra Stores, Patiala at a price of 68,450 Euros
  - Hiring storage space of 485 sq.mtr at Central Warehousing Corporation godown, Ernakulam @ Rs.211/- per sq.mtr for storing equipment from 1<sup>st</sup> November 2014 to 28<sup>th</sup> February 2015
- ❖ The Accommodation Committee meeting under the chairmanship of Shri. A P Anilkumar, Hon'ble Minister for Tourism held on 7<sup>th</sup> October 2014 approved the guidelines to be followed by District Organising Committees (DOC) for identification and selection of accommodation centers as per IOA norms. The Committee also decided that DOCs shall have the discretion to adopt limited tendering/empanelment and negotiation without compromising the quality of service
- ❖ The Core Group meeting of Infrastructure and Overlays Committee held on 7<sup>th</sup> October 2014 recommended the approval of plans presented by M/s. Prime Time Events for overlays at the following venues
  - VKN Menon Indoor Stadium, Thrissur
  - Indoor Stadium, Thriprayar, Thrissur
- ❖ The ICT Committee meeting under the chairmanship of Shri. A Sampath, Hon'ble MP held on 8<sup>th</sup> October 2014 decided to officially launch the National Games Facilitation registration web portal with the participation of Hon'ble Minister for Education & Chairman of the Facilitation Committee and Chairman, ICT Committee
